Yasato distillery (Ibaraki)

Kiuchi Sake Brewery wants to create whiskey that is unique to Japan and takes advantage of Japan's various blessings. In addition to single malt whisky, we also produce a variety of grain whiskies, aiming for a rich Japanese blend. The main ingredients are domestic barley, wheat, and as much Japanese grain as possible, including rice. Furthermore, we use the knowledge we have cultivated over the history of beer and sake brewing to cultivate and use our own yeast.





Chichibu distillery (Saitama)

Established in Chichibu City, Saitama Prefecture. Proud to be Japanese whisky, we produce handcrafted malt whisky, using a small mill, mash tun, fermenter made from Mizunara oak, and pot stills made by Scotland's Forsyth. The harsh environment, with high temperatures and humidity in the summer and freezing temperatures in the winter in the mornings and evenings, is said to have a significant impact on the maturation of whiskey, and despite the short maturation period, the resulting whiskey is fruity and well-balanced.



Hakushu distillery (yamanashi)

In search of a whiskey with a different personality than Yamazaki Distillery, Tameo Onishi, the first chief blender, who was also known as the ``water hunter," searched all over the country in search of the ideal water. It took him several years to arrive at the following., it was Hakushu.

The Hakushu Distillery was completed in 1973, marking 50 years since Suntory first began making whiskey in Japan.





Nirasaki Distillery (yamanashi)

The Nirasaki Mimitsushi Distillery is located on the banks of the Miteshigawa River, at the entrance of the mountain forest that goes up the Miteshigawa River from the Shingen embankment. Currently, the Nirasaki Imperial Envoy Distillery is operating, albeit modestly, within the mirin and cooking sake factory.





Marusu shinshu distillery (Nagano)

This is a Japanese whiskey distillery located in Miyata Village, Kamiina District, Nagano Prefecture. It was opened in 1985 by Honbo Sake Brewery in Kagoshima in search of the perfect environment for making whisky. Located at the foot of Mt. Kisokomagatake at an altitude of 798m, it is the highest whiskey distillery in Japan. We sell Mars whiskey including `Single Malt Komagatake,' which is nurtured by `snowmelt water' and `deep fog' at the foot of Komagatake in the Central Alps.





Fuji gotemba distillery (Shizuoka)

Gaiafuro shizuoka distillery (Shizuoka)

Gaia Flow Shizuoka Distillery is located in Oxyz, a back room in Shizuoka surrounded by rich nature. The underground water that flows from the Southern Alps moistens this land, and eventually transforms into the mighty Abe River, which flows into Suruga Bay. Whiskey is slowly maturing here, where animals live and the beautiful blessings of nature change with the seasons.





Saburomaru distillery (Toyama)

Since we began production in 1952, we have continued to make whiskey with a particular focus on smoky aromas. At the same time, we continue to take on various challenges in order to make this country's whiskey culture even richer. By continuing to innovate on the traditions we have continued to uphold, we will continue to share the whiskey that is unique to Toyama with our deep love for whisky, all over Japan and the world.





Yoro distillery (Gifu)

Yoro Distillery was founded in 1806 and is owned by the long-established Gyokusendo Sake Brewery, which was established in 1934. In the past, during the whiskey boom of the 1970s and 1960s, we supported the boom by selling the blended whiskey "Peak Whiskey." In 2018, Gyokusendo Sake Brewery restarted distilling whiskey for the first time in about 40 years and released the single malt whiskey "Peak Whiskey Newborn 2018."





Chita distillery (Aichi)

This is a rare distillery in the world that produces grain whiskey, which is made from corn as its main ingredient, in a variety of flavors. A variety of grain whiskeys are blended into the internationally acclaimed blended whiskies, Hibiki and Kakubin, to bring out the characteristics of the malt whiskeys produced at Suntory Yamazaki Distillery and Hakushu Distillery, and create a smoother taste. It is essential for Suntory's whisky-making.





Nagahama distillery (Shiga)

The pot stills used at the Nagahama Distillery are extremely unusual in shape and produce a one-of-a-kind sake that cannot be tasted anywhere else. Even during maturation, the wine takes its time in the climate of Nagahama City, Shiga Prefecture, which has a temperature difference of hot in the summer and cold in the winter, and continues to grow slowly until the day when the barrels are opened someday. We will continue to produce world-class whiskey from Japan's smallest distillery.





Ise Distillery (Mie)

In Ise, surrounded by rich nature, we manufacture and sell shochu, sake, liqueurs, whiskey, etc. using underground water from the Isuzu River, which flows through the sacred area of Grand Shrine, and the Miya River, which has been selected as the clearest stream in Japan. I am.





Yamazaki distillery (Osaka)

In 1923, Suntory founder Shinjiro Torii began construction of Japan's first malt whiskey distillery, with a commitment to producing domestically produced whisky. Since then, the Yamazaki Distillery has created the history of Japanese whisky, starting with the first domestically produced whisky, Shirafu, followed by Suntory Whiskey Kakubin, Suntory Old, and many other whiskeys. We have pioneered a Western liquor culture.





Kishu Kumano Distillery (Wakayama)

In May 2019, we opened the Kishu Kumano Distillery with the aim of becoming a 100-year company by 2069. The craft gin contains botanicals from the Kishu-Kumano region, and the whiskey uses clear underground water from the Kii Mountains. The Kishu-Kumano region is a sacred place where the gods dwell, so please enjoy the breath of its divine nature.





Tamba Distillery (Hyogo)

We have been slowly accumulating know-how through craft beer brewing since 1995. Utilizing these sake brewing techniques and experience, we started making whiskey in 2018. In order to realize our ideal of "gorgeous and core flavor," we will continue to make whiskey here in Tamba.





Rokkosan distillery (Hyogo)

The famous peak was born a million years ago. The rain is polished into granite over the years. Here you will find `Mt. Rokko," a malt whiskey made from carefully selected malt whiskey aged in Scotland and adjusted with water from Mt. Rokko. Mt. Rokko coexists with multiple cultures in the city of Kobe, and its values mixed with a million years of memories. Water, forests, and cities: history begins here. Rokkosan Distillery.





Eigashima distillery (Hyogo)

Eigashima Sake Brewery was established in 1984. As far back as the 7th year of the Enpo era, there is a record that Hachibe Urabe of Eigashima was brewing sake. Eigashima Sake Brewery was also the first in the country to introduce sake in one-sho bottles. It also obtained a license to manufacture whiskey in 1919, earlier than Kotobukiya (now Suntory)'s Yamazaki Distillery.





Kurayoshi distillery (Tottori)

Mt. Daisen, a magnificent peak with a natural filtering function, provides Kurayoshi, at its foot, with high-quality water that is indispensable for whisky-making. The origin of the word Kurayoshi is said to be ``living well," and although it snows in the winter, it gets very hot in the summer, with a sharp difference in temperature. As a result, whiskey students progress faster than in the homeland of Ireland, and are able to produce a variety of better whiskies.





Sakurao distillery (Hiroshima)

Founded in 1918 in Sakurao, Hatsukaichi City, Hiroshima Prefecture. Distillation technology that has been passed down for over 100 years. This journey through history has had the support and stories of many people around the world. In 2017, he established "SAKURAO DISTILLERY" to explore new possibilities in the production of whiskey and spirits. We continue to take on challenges for the next 100 years.





Marusutunuki distillery (Kagoshima)

Mars Tsunuki Distillery is a whiskey distillery located in Tsunuki, Kaseda, Minamisatsuma City, Kagoshima Prefecture. At the distillery, which is located in the birthplace of Honbo Sake Brewery, you can see the distillery and other whiskey production equipment, as well as the stone warehouse where a variety of whiskeys are stored.





Ontake distillery (Kagoshima)

A vast hill of approximately 300 hectares overlooking Kinko Bay and Mt. The Mitake Distillery is located here. Mitake Distillery's first new pot was born in winter 2019, making use of the sensibilities of those living in Satsuma and 180 years of distillation technology. The barrels used for aging are all carefully selected old sherry barrels. Here, in these sherry casks, a new life for Japanese whiskey is just beginning.





Kanosuke distillery (Kagoshima)

It started operations in 2018 on a vast site of approximately 9,000 square meters along Fukiage Beach on the west coast of Kagoshima Prefecture. A major feature of the distillery is that it has three pot stills. Worldwide, two distillers are common in microdistilleries. By using pot stills with different neck shapes and line arm angles during re-distilling, Kanosuke Distillery is able to richly vary the aroma and taste.





Susuzaki distillery (Okinawa)

The parent company, Niisato Sake Brewery, was founded in 1846 and is said to be the oldest existing sake brewery in Okinawa. When stored in Okinawa's subtropical climate, the angel's share will be as high as 10% per year, but the barrel components can be extracted quickly, making it possible to produce sake with a strong barrel flavor in a short period of time.





Kiyosu sakura distillery (Aichi)

Kiyosuzakura Jozo Co. is a sake manufacturer based in Kiyosu City, Aichi Prefecture, Japan, founded in 1853 to produce and sell sake, including "Kiyosu Castle Nobunaga Onikoroshi" (Japanese sake).
